

# Yellow Jessamine



**Description:** native; common twining vine in hammocks; recognized by its opposite, lanceolate leaves and showy flowers; all parts of the plant are toxic; blooms late winter to early spring

**Family:** Gelsemiaceae

**Scientific name:**

*Gelsemium sempervirens*
