Plant Type: Perennial Sun: Half, Shade

Water: Medium, Extra in Summer

This perennial will grow about 1-3' tall and has medium-sized green leaves with red/scarlet flowers

that bloom in spring and summer.

This shrub is highly appreciated for its decorative characteristics, which include a dense show of small, pale pink urn-shaped flowers in winter and spring. One of its main often overlooked attractions of this plant is the mahogany-red to brown bark (which peels beautifully) that can be revealed with some internal pruning once the plant is mature . It's small, red fruit resembles the tike apple, appearing at the end of winter just as Spring is coming on. Evergreen, shiny leaves are very neat and tidy. It can reach 8' tall and 10 wide. It can be pruned to desired size. This shrub attracts b ...

A hardy, creeping evergreen shrub, it grows 6"-12" high and spreads as much as 10"-12'. It has glossy green leathery leaves attached to dark brown branches. Its flowers are white to light pink in late winter and early spring; berries are bright red.

Fast-growing, easy evergreen groundcover to 2' tall and 12' wide. Native from Baja to the Oregon coast in dunes and bluffs in coastal scrub, and dry slopes and woods in chaparral, woodlands, and mixed evergreen forests. Tolerates ocean spray and is deer resistant. Preferred coyote bush for slope stabilization and landscaping, coastal or inland. Prefers full sun and well-drained soil, but tolerates alkaline, sandy, or clay soil. Once mature, tolerates dryness; looks better, grows faster, and is healthier with some summer water. White, insignificant flowers in fall. Plant 6-10 feet apart for ...

Plant Type: Grass

Cool-season bunchgrass native to northern California coastal scrub. Grows 1' tall and 2' wide, with arching blue-green foliage that often has purple highlights. Silver-purple flower heads appear mid-spring through early summer, turning a golden wheat tone in fall. Plant along the coast in full sun or light shade inland in well-drained soil. Tolerates drier conditions when grown in shade but looks best with occasional to regular irrigation. Tolerates wind and salt spray and is resistant to predation by herbivores. Does NOT respond well to being chopped back. Instead, divide existing clumps ...

Botanical Name: *Calamagrostis nutkaensis* **Common Name:** Pacific Reed Grass

Plant Type: Grass Sun: Full, Half Water: Low, Medium

A large handsome bunch grass from the coastal regions of Monterey County to Alaska that forms huge tussocks in open moist meadows and on coastal bluffs. It can also be found as an understory at the edges of coniferous forests. Wide green blades grow 2 - 3 ft. tall with flowering culms to 4 ft. Good background or accent plant for the woodland or meadow. Will take full sun in somewhat cooler areas. Best with some summer water and partial shade inland. Deer resistant. -Cal Flora Nursery

CA native Carex stays 6" or under and spreads up to 2' by rhizomes. Can be used as a naturalistic lawn substitute. Requires significant water to obtain good coverage, but once coverage is reached water can be reduced and maintenance is close to zero. Unmowed, the plant can be used effectively in a variety of conditions. Prefers sandy soil.

Botanical Name: *Carex tumulicola* **Common Name:** Foothill Sedge

Plant Type: Grass Sun: Full, Half Water: Medium

Carex tumulicola, or foothill sedge, is an evergreen perennial sedge that grows in 1-2' arching clumps. It is native to open woods, meadows and coastal prairies from the central coast of California north to Oregon and Washington. Features narrow, grasslike, medium green leaves to 18" long and 1/8" wide. Brown, non-showy flowers bloom in spring atop stems rising above the foliage. This easy-care plant is useful as an informal groundcover under shrubs or trees, for a meadow-like look, or for soil stabilization where the rhizomatous roots help control erosion. Prefers some shade unless on th ...

Concha is a lilac that grows 6'-8' in height and width. It has small narrow, glossy, dark green leaves with intense dark blue flower clusters in spring. It is tolerant of coastal and inland conditions. Most ceanothus varieties do not tolerate a lot of summer irrigation but this cultivar does. It also tolerates clay and alkali soil better than other varieties. It is hard frost tolerant.

Botanical Name: Ceanothus 'Ray Hartman' Common Name: Ray Hartman California Lilac

Plant Type: Tree, Shrub

Water: Low, Extra in Summer

Growing vigorously as either a large shrub or small tree, the Ray Hartman has big, round, dark green leaves and medium blue, delicate flowers in 3"-5" clusters that bloom in winter and spring. It grows to 12' high and 8'-10' wide. This cultivar has good tolerance for heat; it needs occasional deep watering with good drainage. It does well in coastal as well as inland valley gardens. Deer love new foliage. Plant in full to part sun; it is not fussy about soil, growing in clay as well as sandy soil.

This shrub, also used as ground cover, can reach 3' high and 4'-6' wide. Foliage is evergreen, dark green, resembling holly leaves with spines. During spring, dark blue flower clusters cover the plant. The shrub has slightly arching branches. This is a great plant for coastal areas, tolerating full sun and salt spray. Deer tend to stay away from this cultivar as the spines discourage browsing. It does best with afternoon shade in warm, inland valleys and additional summer irrigation. It also frost hardy to 15 degrees F. This plant is great for erosion control on hillsides. Butterflies love ...

Sticky monkey flower is a drought tolerant evergreen shrub 2-3' tall with numerous tubular orange-yellow flowers in spring and summer. Grows on hillsides and along the coast, where it prefers good drainage and somewhat dry conditions. Prefers full sun near coast, light shade inland. This California native provides nectar for hummingbirds and is a larval food source for the common checkerspot and buckeye butterflies. Deer resistant. Trim annually to maintain shape.

Botanical Name: *Epilobium canum* Common Name: California Fuchsia

Plant Type: Perennial

Sun: Full

Water: Very Low

Dense, sprawling perennial to 2' tall and 5' wide, with gray-green foliage and tubular orange to scarlet red summer-fall flowers that attract hummingbirds. Prefers cool sun but also tolerates part-shade or hot sun with water. Performs in iffy soil (including clay) and is drought tolerant once established, making it a good choice for dry gardens, hillsides, neglected areas, and parking strips. Cut foliage to ground in winter when foliage is dormant. The name Epilobium is considered current but this group of sub-shrubs used to be called Zauschneria and are so different from the other Epi ...

Perennial grows 1' tall and 1.5' wide. Has deep green foliage and lavender flowers with gold centers. Blooms spring through fall if deadheaded. Does well in coastal areas where it can be planted in full sun. Prefers afternoon shade inland. Requires little water once established but looks better with extra summer water. Attracts bees and butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.

St. Catherine's Lace is a large open shrub growing 4'-5' high and 3'-4' wide. Evergreen leaves are oval shaped, silvery on top and woolly white on bottom. During spring, flat clusters of tiny, cream colored flowers appear reminding one of Granny's lace doilies. These flowers turn rust in summer and fall. It is a full-sun California native that does well in coastal areas, not needing irrigation once established. In warmer, inland areas, this plant will also thrive with minimal watering. It attracts butterflies and beneficial insects. It does best with well draining soil but tolerates clay s ...

San Miguel Island Buckwheat is a low growing shrub 1'-2' high and 3' wide. This attractive California native has a prostrate habit. It has showy, dark pink summer flowers held on stems above the foliage. Leaves are evergreen and spoon-shaped; leaves on upper surface are gray green and lower surface is woolly. It does well in coastal and inland valley areas, needing very little irrigation once it's established. It tolerates clay soil. It attracts butterflies.

The California Fescue is a cool season bunchgrass with blue-green blades that reach 2' high. The violet colored flower stalks are 5' tall, appearing in spring and summer, creating fountain-like clumps. This grass is drought tolerant for sun and shade although it looks better with additional summer water. The California fescue is a beneficial insect plant. Plant on dry sunny slopes or on the edge of a dry creek bed.

This ground cover is a California native found in mountain areas and coastal hillsides. This perennial has medium-sized green, evergreen, fragrant leaves. During spring and summer, tiny white flowers appear followed by tasty red berries. This ground cover is less than 1' tall but will spread 10' wide. Works in shady or sunny areas, under oaks and conifers. This ground cover needs regular watering. It will tolerate clay soil, occasional flooding and deer. It looks great in hanging baskets and covering retaining walls!

Easy-care, long-lived evergreen shrub grows 6'-8' tall and wide, sometimes larger, with a rounded form that can be pruned to shape. Native in chaparral, woodland, and forest communities from Oregon coast ranges through most of California into Arizona and Baja. Foliage is large, leathery, deep green with reddish tints, stems are reddish brown when young, spring flowers are inconspicuous but attract butterflies and bees. Leaf edges curl under during dry summers to conserve moisture. Red berries turn black in late summer, when they attract birds (and resemble coffee beans). Tolerates sun or p ...

Evergreen shrub typically grows up to 8' tall and 5' wide, sometimes larger, with leathery, toothed, green leaves. Small, white, fragrant flowers appear in late spring or early summer, followed by clusters of red winter berries. Tolerates full sun, part shade, heat, smog, wind, and heavy or light soils. Established plants are drought tolerant. May take several years to become established, after which it's great for erosion control. Prune a little bit all year long if desired, or wait till August/September for a heavier prune.

This attractive California native has 2"-3" wide, evergreen leaves that are dark green but may turn reddish in winter. Foliage is mounding and dense. During spring, thin vertical stems emerge covered with small light pink flowers. Overall height of plant in bloom is 3' tall, spreading up to 2'. This Heuchera tolerates full sun in coastal areas but needs afternoon shade or full shade in warm inland areas. Can be planted under oaks. This plant tolerates clay soil. Established plants need only occasional water. Hummingbirds love these plants.

Douglas iris is an evergreen perennial that can reach 2' tall and spread 3' wide. It tolerates full sun in coastal areas but needs afternoon shade in warm inland valleys. Foliage is long, pointed and lovely green. It prefers rich soil. Not frost tolerant; does not tolerate gravel soil. Lavender blue flowers with lots of streaks appear in spring. Medium watering required. Beautiful when planted en masse under oak trees.

Good on banks of seasonal creeks, along roads or in gullies where runoff forms in winter. Prefers sun, not picky about soil, and looks best with water once or twice a month once it's established. Very long-lived.

It does well in full sun and is drought tolerant once it's established. It tolerates coastal, desert and mountain areas. Do not over fertilize. It needs well draining soil. Birds love this plant too!

Native to California's Channel Islands, the Catalina cherry is an evergreen shrub or small tree that grows 15' to 30' tall and wide, usually smaller and upright. Makes a nice tall, dense screen or hedge. Easily pruned to shape or control size. Develops showy white flower spikes in spring that bees adore and dark red-purple fruit in fall that is cherished by birds. Catalina cherry is drought tolerant, resists oak root fungus, and attracts beneficial insects and butterflies.

Stately drought-resistant tree grows from Mendocino to Baja, Mexico. Among the most important wildlife plants, provides critical habitat for 700+ insects and numerous birds and animals. Dominant overstory plant of the Coast Live Oak woodland, often with Bay Laurel and California Buckeye north of Big Sur. Evergreen and roundheaded, it has variable holly-like leaves, grows 2' per year, and can live 250 years. Reaches 20' to 70' tall and wide (wider than tall with age). Helps control erosion and maintain a healthy balance of beneficial insects. Spring male flowers are pendulous catkins, fem ...

Sugar Bush is a dense, rounded evergreen shrub growing 8'-15' tall and wide with creamy flowers in spring. Small red fruit follows blooms, which are edible. It grows well in inland areas and is drought tolerant. Leathery, rich, dark foliage is evergreen. It prefers full sun and well draining soil. It is drought tolerant once it's established although it could use additional irrigation in hot summer areas. Do not plant in wet areas.

Woody shrub has stiff, upright stems with highly pungent, gray-green, wrinkled evergreen juvenile leaves that become smooth and white. Fragrant white-lavender flowers bloom in spring, attracting bees. Likes sunny dry slopes, fast-draining soil, and no extra water after the first year. May reach 6' tall and wide over time, although it is considered slow growing. (A compact variety grows about half this size.) Prune after bloom. Leaves used for herbal teas and for medicinal purposes. Native Americans created smudge sticks from this plant for use in sweat lodges and ceremonies.

It is cold and heat tolerant, growing in desert and coastal areas. It tolerates sandy and clay soil. Very reliable.

Hummingbird sage is endemic to California, where it is found at low elevations of the Coast Ranges from San Bruno Mountain to Orange County. Fragrant, fruity foliage spreads by rhizomes. Flower stems rise 2 - 3 ft. above the leaves in spring, with ball-like clusters of deep fuchsia flowers. Loved by hummingbirds. Does best in cool sun or part shade in hot areas. Drought tolerant, but looks best with occasional summer water. Deer resistant. Excellent for dry shade and under oaks.

Following winter rains, this grassy perennial brings a soft texture back into the garden. It produces an abundance of small blue-purple flowers which have a long bloom cycle. The foliage is similar to Irises. This California native prefers full sun and is drought tolerant once it's established. It's great in small spaces and among rocks. This plant reaches about 1' tall.
